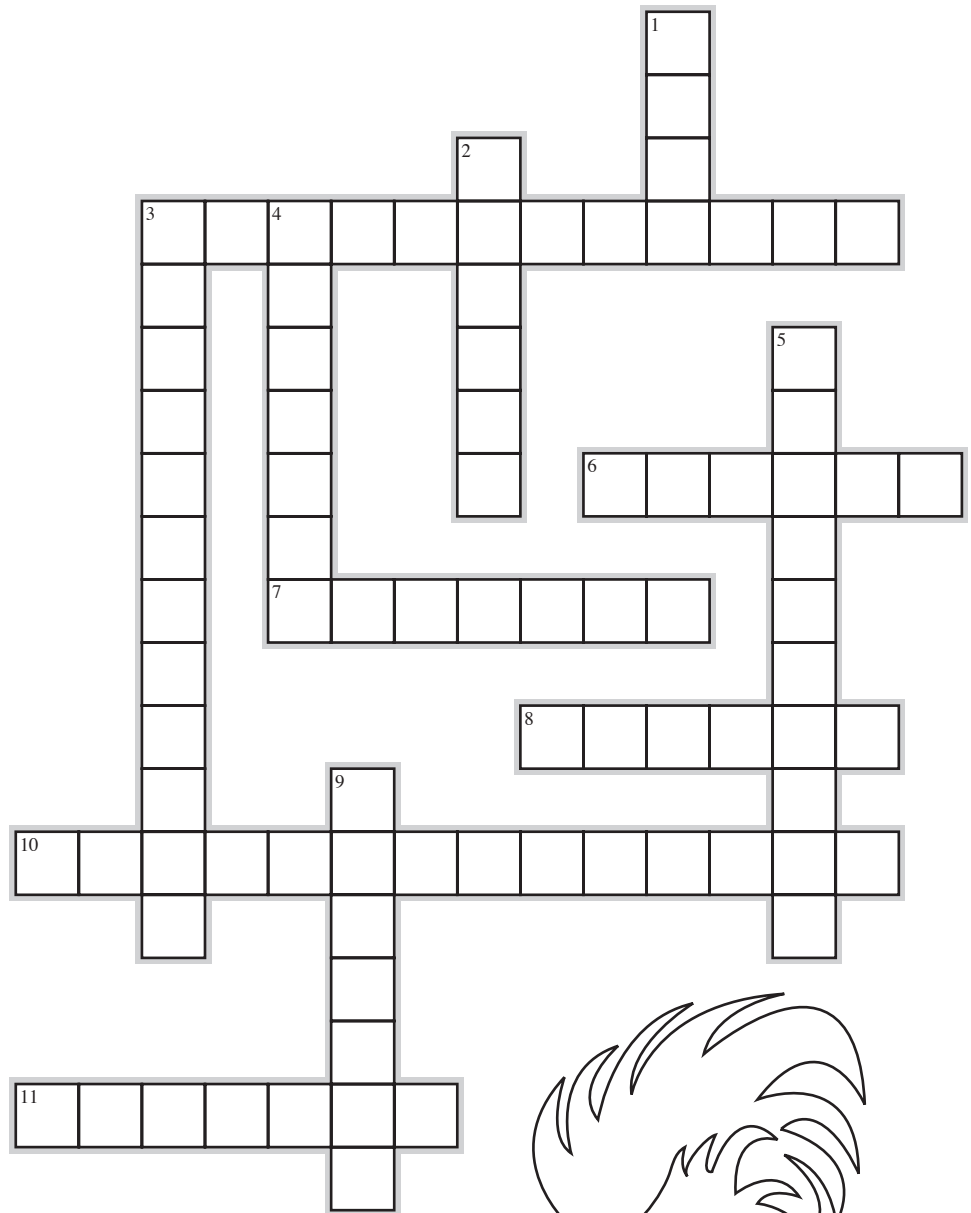

ACROSS

- 3 THIS ANIMAL IS FASTER AND MORE AGILE THAN ITS SPRAYING COUSIN
- 6 TO PROTECT ITSELF FROM PREDATORS, THIS CREATURE BUILDS DAMS
- 7 THESE AQUATIC RODENTS GIVE OFF QUITE A MUSKY ODOR
- 8 ALSO KNOWN AS PRAIRIE WOLF
- 10 THESE ANIMALS' SLENDER BODIES ALLOW THEM TO TRAP THEIR PREY INTO THEIR BURROWS
- 11 THIS OMNIVORE CAN CLIMB TREES

DOWN

- 1 PARKS HELP TO PROTECT THESE ANIMALS THAT ARE USED FOR EXPENSIVE COATS
- 2 THIS CREATURE HAS THE WIDEST RANGE OF ANY TERRESTRIAL CARNIVORE (NORTH AMERICA, EUROPE, ASIA, AND AUSTRALIA)
- 3 THIS CREATURE IS MAINLY SEEN (BUT MOSTLY SMELLED) AROUND TWILIGHT
- 4 WHEN THREATENED THIS NOCTURNAL CREATURE WILL PLAY DEAD
- 5 ANIMAL LIKES TO SLIDE ON ITS BELLY
- 9 WHEN CAMPING PUT YOUR FOOD UP AT NIGHT OR THIS NOCTURNAL ANIMAL WEARING "SHADES" MIGHT GET INTO IT
